

## Accommodation Information for Exchange and Study Abroad Students



The Student Affairs Office (SAO) manages a limited number of rooms on the 14<sup>th</sup> floor of the student dormitory (*Block P - a new building just opened to student in 2015*) for exchange/study abroad students.

Rooms are allocated on a 'first come, first served' basis. Please apply as early as possible.

In the event of a room on campus not being available, the University will provide assistance in your seeking accommodation off-campus.

## **ROOMS AND FEES**

There is only one type of dormitory room offered for <u>exchange/study abroad students</u>. You may choose single or double occupancy:

Single occupancy: Hong Kong Dollars (HKD) 5,200 per month

Double occupancy: Hong Kong Dollars (HKD) 3,150/student/month

The fees include basic furniture, water, electricity, and 24-hour internet.

\*Bedding is not included, you can order from us. A set of bedding costs HKD 1,100 which includes two fitted bed sheets, a blanket, a duvet with two covers and a pillow with two pillowcases. Or you can bring your own bedding.

(These can also be purchased cheaply from large supermarkets locally)

- Rooms are limited, if we are unable to make you a single room offer, you may
  have to share the room with another student that we assign.
- Vice versa, if we cannot find you a room-mate, you may have to pay for single occupancy.





**Double Room** 

There is an option to request for a regular 4-student dormitory room. This type of room is prioritized for regular university students.

Fees: Hong Kong Dollars (HKD) 1,500 per month per student

**Electricity cost**: Share monthly power bill with room mates

**Other cost:** Hong Kong Dollars (HKD) 1,800 bedding (one-off payment, not refundable or transferable)

The fees include basic furniture and broad band service, and internet (which is terminated at midnight).

## **CHANGING ROOMS**

If for some reason you want to request for a change of room after moving in to the reserved room, a (HKD) 500 relocation fee will be charged on successful application.
